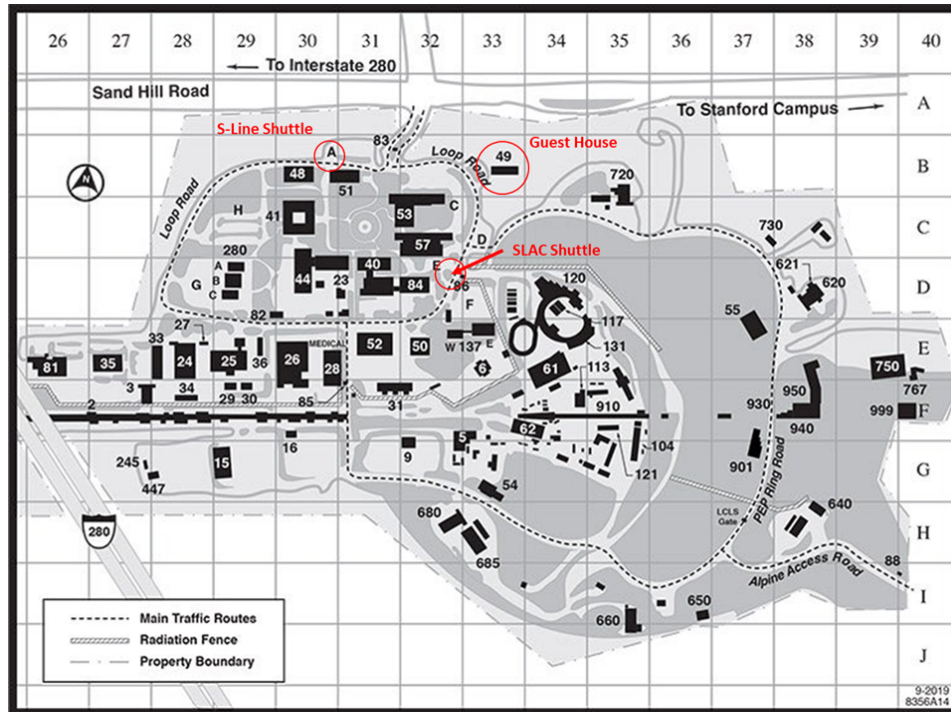


Stanford Marguerite – Free Shuttle Service

Stanford offers free shuttle services (Stanford Marguerite) around campus, to SLAC, and to the Palo Alto Caltrain Platform. General details can be found [here](#) with a live map of the shuttle service can be viewed [here](#).

Getting between SLAC and Stanford Campus: There are bus lines that have stops at SLAC and Stanford campus, the SLAC-line and the S-line. The SLAC-line will be the easiest to use as it runs Monday-Friday throughout the day. The timetable for the SLAC line shuttle service to and from SLAC and the Stanford campus can be found [here](#). Stop number #315 is located near building #57 (Arrillaga Science center, circled on SLAC the map below) on SLAC. The stop on Stanford campus (#236) is in front of The Yang and Yamazki Environment and Energy (Y2E2) Building which is right next to the Shriram Center.

Getting around Stanford Campus: Campus is a great place for walking, but walking from opposite sides of campus can take 20 minutes or so. To quickly get around the perimeter of campus we recommend using the X- and Y-lines. The timetable for X line (counter-clockwise) shuttle service on Stanford campus can be found [here](#). The timetable for Y line (clockwise) shuttle service on Stanford campus can be found [here](#). Both of these lines have stops at Stanford stop #236 outside the Y2E2 building making it easy to transfer to or from the SLAC-line.
